*And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another* (Hebrews 10:24-25)

Together we do amazing things. Off the top of my head, here are a few recent things:

Together with one another we have just experienced a joy-filled Advent and Christmas season of worship. Together with one another we raised over \$500 on our Christ Tree to help two families from among us experience a bit more joy in their own celebrations too.

Together with our community we hosted the Christmas Day Dinner, feeding nearly 500 people and sharing the blessings of being in community with volunteers and diners. Together with our community we are participating in Hope at the Inn, and preparing for our turn to host January 26 to February 2. Together with our community we support food pantries and school children.

Together with the Northern Skies District, Michigan Conference, and our United Methodist denomination we reach out through God's Country Cooperative Parish in the Upper Peninsula, support Camp Michigamme, respond to disasters, help refugees, provide education from preschool through seminary, and fund the infrastructure to make ministry happen around the world.

Together with God we celebrate the sacraments of baptism (two since I've arrived in July and at least a couple more in the planning) and holy communion (the first Sunday of every month in worship). Together with God we proclaim the love of Jesus Christ every day in untold ways.

Together with God, our denomination, our community, and one another, we do these amazing things and so much more. It is an amazing blessing to be in ministry together with you all and God.

As we move into this new year together, I'm inviting us to take up the challenge of EngageMI offered by the Michigan Conference of the United Methodist Church. EngageMI is similar to what you may have known as being a Spotlight Church, something Memorial UMC achieved for many, many years.

EngageMI challenges congregations to comprehensive missional learning, giving and action with the goal of encouraging congregations to shift from offering "ministry to" others to a more relational way of being in "ministry with" vulnerable people and communities. Ministry with is grounded in Jesus' practice of ministry, and our Wesleyan heritage. You can dig deeper into this now at <https://michiganumc.org/missions/engage-mi/>, or just come along with us this year as we learn, give, and act together.

We'll be starting in January by learning all we do together already to be in ministry with local schools and students. We have an opportunity to watch a webinar together on January 22 to learn how others are engaging with local schools and students. Then, together we can give and act in the best way possible, with schools and students, each other, and God. That's just one example of how EngageMI is intended to work.

I'm looking forward to giving it a try together with you all and with God.

May this be a year full of God's blessings, of learning, giving, and acting to proclaim the love of Jesus Christ, together.

The Financial Secretary keeps track of all donations that are identifiable, i.e. a check, an electronic donation through Vanco or the Square Reader, or cash in any envelope marked with your name or your official box number.

**Cards needed** If you have un-used thinking of you, sympathy, or get well cards, please give them to Nancy Campbell. This will help supplement the ones she makes and sends out to our church family.

**Puzzles:** If you enjoy working jigsaw puzzles, there are puzzles in the church library. Take one home, enjoy working it and return when finished. There will be new ones added on a regular basis. Our winters are long — hope you enjoy working them as much as we do.

### Open Office Hours: 10 a.m. – 1 p.m. Monday, Wednesday, Thursday

I'll be at the church and generally available to meet with whoever drops by. (I'm glad to meet at other times and places by appointment.)

Email is best for sending information, asking non-urgent questions, and conducting church business. I generally respond to email within 24 hours, if not sooner Sunday through Thursday; Fridays and Saturdays I may not be checking as often.

### Office Phone: (906) 428-9311

The Office is open 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. Monday – Thursday, staffed by Lisa Myers, who generally knows where I am if I'm not in the office. If you leave a message on the office answering machine, either Lisa or I will respond as soon as possible. I do check messages on Sunday morning before and after worship services. Messages left on Friday or Saturday might not be heard until Sunday.

### Cell Phone: (734) 646-6922

Call or text if you have an urgent need to contact me. Between 10 p.m. and 8 a.m., I'd prefer it be a serious need that cannot wait. Anytime you call and I don't answer, please leave a voice message. I will listen to the message and return the call as soon as possible, usually in a few minutes and seldom longer than an hour.

### Facebook:

I use this only at the office and I'm new to it, so it's not a reliable way to contact me for something urgent or important. I often "schedule" posts for the church page, so new posts don't always mean I'm working right then. That's it for me and social media, so if you're using anything else, I won't know it.
